

Packing List for International Flights

One week until departure:

- Call credit card companies to let them know you'll be travelling abroad
- Get cash and convert to local currency (or pay a little more and do it while passing through any major airports)
- Study up on history, locations, simple phrases, etc.
- Check to see what kind of electric plug converter you may need for destination country
- Upload books/movies/games on tablets & devices
- Schedule a ride/cab to/from airport
- Final check in with any house sitter you might have

- Compost/trash out
- Finish laundry

- Leave out house sitting instructions
- Passport
- Passport copies

- Pre-departure packet
- Phrase and/or guidebook

- Camera (batteries)
- Converter(s)
- Sunglasses
